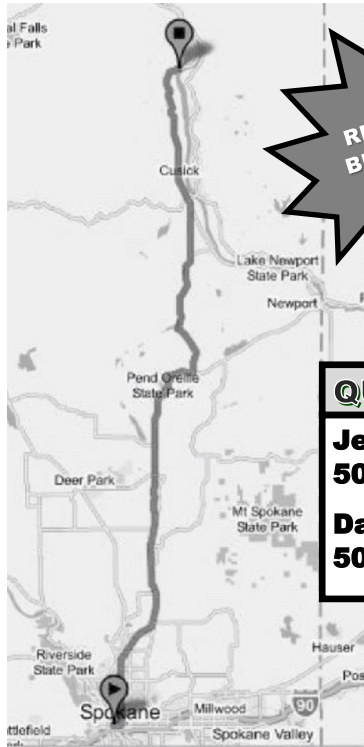


\$\$ MONEY SAVING IDEAS \$\$
